Travel Requirements for International Boarding Students

In compliance with SEVIS regulations, it is strongly recommended that each international student hand carry the following documentation when traveling:

- Passport and visa
- I-20 signed and stamped
- I-94 signed and stamped
- Evidence of financial resources (bank statement)
- Evidence of student status, such as recent tuition receipts and transcripts
- Paper receipt for the SEVIS fee, Form I-797
- Name and contact information for your "Designated School Official", including a 24-hour emergency contact number at the school.

All international students are required to turn in these documents to the Admissions Office upon arrival at school. All documents will be kept in the Residential Life locked safe and be returned to each student when needed.
