OVERVIEW

Summer@Farragut is a unique six-week boarding experience for teens entering grades 8-12. They will attend college-prep classes and participate in fun activities while living in campus dormitories at *Admiral Farragut Academy*. **Completion of a six-week academic course earns a full high school credit.** Students may also choose to attend camp for two-week, four-week, or six-week sessions, for no credit. Elective courses, also for no credit, meet for two consecutive weeks unless otherwise noted.

Daily on-campus activities include games, competitions, movie nights, and waterfront activities (kayak, paddleboarding, and sailing). Weekly excursions include trips to nearby beaches, amusement parks, shopping, whitewater rafting, ziplining, and more!

Attendees will be able to strengthen their academics and learn about different countries and cultures from the diverse group of other camp-goers. In the past years, attendees represented many areas of the world including China, Colombia, Denmark, Italy, Peru, Russia, Spain, and Ukraine to name a few, as well as numerous states within the United States of America.

Summer@ TUITION

SIX-WEEK SESSION: \$6,500

FOUR-WEEK SESSION: \$4,500

TWO-WEEK SESSION: \$2,500

The above program fees (in U.S. funds) for Summer@ attendees cover:

- Bus transportation between Tampa International Airport and our school's campus at scheduled times on July 2, 16, 30, and August 13, 2016
- Tuition for all academic and elective courses and sports, except additional fees as noted below
- Meals and housing
- Medical services at the school's infirmary
- Bed linens, towels, pillows, and blankets
- Weekly laundry service
- All class-related trips

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

Other expenses not included in each program's fee:

- **TRANSPORTATION** to/from Admiral Farragut Academy (except for the school buses to/from Tampa International Airport at scheduled times).
- **\$200 HEALTH INSURANCE**—students are required to have health insurance that provides medical coverage while they are attending Summer@Farragut. International students are required to purchase Admiral Farragut Academy insurance (U.S. medical providers cannot bill to overseas insurance companies and international travel insurance policies will not be approved by Admiral Farragut Academy's Health Services). For U.S.

residents, participation in Admiral Farragut Academy's insurance is voluntary if they are covered under another adequate health insurance policy, which must be approved by the Infirmary.

- **\$150 NON-REFUNDABLE ACTIVITIES FEE** (per each two-week session). Required fee covers all on-campus social activities and most off-campus trips such as excursions to the Magic Kingdom, Universal Studios, Busch Gardens, Tampa Bay Rays baseball game, whitewater rafting, zip-lining, shopping malls, movie theaters, and more.

- **SPENDING MONEY**—Summer@Farragut spending accounts must be set up ahead of time when paying the tuition bill by including \$50 for each week of attendance. Funds can also be added throughout the summer either via check or wire transfer should they need it. Please note we leave campus twice a week for full-day excursions and twice for evening excursions, during which time your child may want/need spending money. Additionally, please be aware there is no ATM on campus.
