*Boarding Tuition* includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner on the weekdays and brunch and dinner on the weekends, except for when dormitories are closed.

### NOT INCLUDED IN TUITION:

#### APPLIES TO ALL STUDENTS

**Uniforms** - Initial cost is approx. \$1,000. Available for purchase in the school store (Ship's Store) or used uniform store (Lucky Bag).

**Books** - Cost varies per student and course selection. New and used books may be purchased online.

**Field Trips** - Cost varies based on trip.

**School Supplies** - Cost varies depending on what student purchases.

**Extracurricular Activities** - After the academic day.

#### MAY APPLY TO STUDENTS

**AP Course Test Fees** - \$95 per exam

**Aviation Course Fees** - Aero Science I - \$100, Aero Science II - \$1,500, Aviation Academy - \$14,000

**Center for Academic Success Services**

Tutoring - Cost varies depending on student needs.

Academic Coaching Class - \$1,700 per semester

**International Students Only**

ESOL Classes - \$750 per class, per semester

Medical Insurance for International Students - \$425

**\*STUDENT EXPENSE ACCOUNT - This account is mandatory for all boarding students.**
