#### **ACADEMICS:**

## THREE TRACKS OFFERED

### 1. TRADITIONAL PROGRAM

June 29 - August 10, 2019. Offered as a 2-, 3-, 4-, 5-, or 6-week session. Attendees may choose to enroll in academic and elective courses for no credit or attend the full 6-week session to receive a high school credit. Example of courses offered:

### 2. ESL IMMERSION

June 29 - August 10, 2019. Offered as a 2-, 3-, 4-, 5-, or 6-week session. Attendees do not receive academic credit, but will see a drastic improvement in their English listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. They will also gain the experience needed to score high in the TOEFL test. This program is highly encouraged for international students entering their first academic year at Admiral Farragut Academy.

### 3. COLLEGE PREP

Session I: June 29 - July 20, 2019. Session II: July 20 - August 10, 2019. Offered as a 3-week session program designed to help international students gain a better understanding of the college admissions process in the United States. During the first and third week, students will research colleges, learn about the various types of applications, write essays, develop a college resume, and tour various Florida universities and colleges. During the second week, the group will travel to the Northeastern United States for college tours at various universities in the Boston and New York City area, including Harvard and Yale.

## PRICING

Fees are listed in U.S. dollars and are non-refundable.

### TRADITIONAL PROGRAM & ESL IMMERSION:

- 6-week Session: \$5,000

#### Traditional Program Only

- 6-week In-Person Academic Course: \$2,750 (for local day students)
- 6-week Online Academic Course: \$2,000

### COLLEGE PREP:

- 3-week Session: \$5,250
- Also includes flights and hotels to Northeastern colleges and universities

### PRICING INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

- All academic and elective courses and sports, except *additional fees*\*
- Meals and housing
- Medical services at the school's infirmary
- Bed linens, towels, pillows, and blankets
- Weekly laundry service
- All class-related trips
- All off-campus excursions
- *Transportation*\*\* to/from the Tampa International Airport (TPA)

### \*Additional Fees Include:

- **\$200 Health Insurance:** Attendees are required to have health insurance that provides medical coverage while they are attending Summer@Farragut regardless of duration. This is a flat fee which can cover a two-week session up to a six-week session.
  - International attendees are required to purchase Admiral Farragut Academy insurance. U.S. medical providers cannot bill to overseas insurance companies and international travel insurance policies are not approved by Admiral Farragut Academy's Health Services.
  - U.S. residents **MUST** provide proof of insurance or they will be unable to attend.
- **\$50 Spending Money Fee Per Week:** Summer@Farragut spending money accounts must be set up ahead of time, when paying the tuition, by including an additional \$50 per each week of attendance. Additional spending money may be added throughout the summer either via check or wire transfer. Please note we leave campus twice a week for full-day excursions and an average of twice a week for evening excursions, during which time your child may want/need spending money. Please be aware there is not an ATM on campus.

### \*\* Transportation is Provided for:

- Arrivals in TPA on Saturdays, June 29, July 6, 13, 20, & 27 between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. (EST).
- Departures from TPA on Saturdays July 13, 20, & 27, and August 3 & 10 between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. (EST).
