PRICING DOES INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- All academic and elective courses and sports
- Meals and housing
- Medical services at the school's infirmary
- Bed linens, towels, pillows, and blankets
- Weekly laundry service

- Transportation to/from Tampa International Airport (TPA)
 - Arrivals in TPA on Saturdays (session start dates only) between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. (EST).
 - Departures from TPA on Saturdays (session end dates only) between 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. (EST).
 - If attendees are arriving/departing at different days/ hours, they must schedule and pay for their own airport transportation with www.hhlimo.com.
- \$50 Spending Money Fee Per Week
 - Spending money is included in the weekly pricing and payment is collected during enrollment. Each attendee will have their own spending money account.
 - Additional spending money may be added throughout the summer either via check or wire transfer.
 - Please note, we leave campus on average 2x a week for full-day excursions and 2x week for evening excursions.
 - Please be aware there is not an ATM on campus.

PRICING DOES NOT INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- Health Insurance
 - Attendees are required to have health insurance that provides medical coverage while they are attending Summer@Farragut regardless of duration.
 - If the child is an international student, the family is required to pay a flat fee of \$200 for health insurance provided by Admiral Farragut Academy. U.S. medical providers cannot bill to overseas insurance companies and international travel insurance policies are not approved by Admiral Farragut Academy's Health Services.
 - If your child is a U.S. citizen there are no fees, but you
 must provide proof of health insurance or they will be
 unable to attend. Insurance through Farragut is only
 available for international attendees.
