- Current students cannot be re-enrolled until the previous year's tuition is paid.

INCLUDED IN TUITION

All meals including breakfast, lunch, and dinner on the weekdays and brunch and dinner on the weekends, except for when dormitories are closed.

NOT INCLUDED IN TUITION

- **ANNUAL ENROLLMENT FEE** An additional \$200 is required for all new and returning students and is due with the enrollment contract.
- **STUDENT EXPENSE ACCOUNT** \$2,500 for *new* boarding students \$1,500 for *returning* boarding students
 - This account is mandatory for all boarding students.
 - The student expense account may be replenished by VISA or MC (3% fee), check, or cash, when the balance is low or depleted.
 - The following are some common items, but not all, for which the Student Account is used:
 - Naval Science uniforms
 - AP course test fees, homework helper program, and field trips
 - Athletic, extracurricular and after school activities
 - Purchases in the school Ship's Store
