- If a family is choosing to pay on a payment plan, A 5.6%\* Tuition Refund Insurance fee is required for all payment plans. Tuition Refund Insurance is optional if paying in full.
- Regardless of the date of enrollment or re-enrollment, if any payment plan is selected, you are responsible for all retroactive payments due starting on July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Current students cannot be re-enrolled until the previous year's tuition is paid.

### INCLUDED IN TUITION

- All meals including breakfast, lunch, and dinner on the weekdays and brunch and dinner on the weekends, except for when dormitories are closed.

### NOT INCLUDED IN TUITION

- **ANNUAL ENROLLMENT FEE** - An additional \$200 is required for all new and returning students and is due with the enrollment contract.

- **STUDENT EXPENSE ACCOUNT** - \$2,500 for new boarding students  
\$1,500 for returning boarding students

- This account is mandatory for all boarding students.
- The student expense account may be replenished by VISA or MC (3% fee), check, or cash, when the balance is low or depleted.
- The following are some common items, but not all, for which the Student Account is used:

- Naval Science uniforms
- AP course test fees, homework helper program, and field trips
- Athletic, extracurricular and after school activities
- Purchases in the school Ship's Store
- Doctor's appointments and prescriptions
- Replacement of room key if lost
- On-campus haircuts
- School pictures
- Taxis or airport shuttles
- And other miscellaneous charges

### ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND/OR COURSES

- **Center for Academic Success Services**
  - Cost varies for reading or tutoring services.
  - Cost for Academic Coaching Class is \$3,500.
- **Signature Courses**
  - Aviation Course Fees - Aeronautical Science I & II \$100 plus flight time expenses, Aviation Academy \$15,000
  - Scuba Course Fees - Basic Scuba \$1,100, Master Diver \$600, and Dive Master \$500
